

## Finite type Polish groups

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Abstract: Popa introduced a class of finite type Polish group. A Polish group is called of finite type if is embeddable into the unitary group of some  $II_1$  factor. These groups are the target groups of his famous cocycle superrigidity theorem. Popa posed a following question: if a Polish group  $G$  has a two-sided invariant metric and is embeddable into the unitary group of a Hilbert space, is  $G$  necessarily of finite type? In this talk I present partial positive answers to the question.
