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Tree systems and trees of graphs as boundaries of hyperbolic groups

Abstract: Classification of Gromov boundaries of hyperbolic groups is very far from being completed. In this talk I will focus on a class of topological spaces called "trees of graphs" (which will be defined in the talk). I will present a result towards a classification (or characterization) of those hyperbolic groups whose Gromov boundary is (homeomorphic to) a tree of graphs. The characterization will be given in terms of features of the so called "Bowditch's JSJ decomposition of a hyperbolic group - the concept which will be also explained, at least to some extent, in the talk. The main technical tool used to obtain the above mentioned result is that of a "tree system of compact metric spaces". I will explain this term, and sketch a proof of the result, emphasising the role of tree systems in this proof.
